Make Your Own Giraffe

Spoon Puppet

YOU WILL NEED: A wooden Spoon Coloured Pens PVA Glue & Sticky Tape Card Scrap Brown Felt Pieces (optional)



STEP 1: Colour/paint your spoon Yellow




<u>STEP 2</u>: Cut out some brown patches for your giraffe in felt (or alternatively you can draw them on and colour them in.)



<u>STEP 3</u>: Position your patches and glue them on. Have a play and see what different patterns you can create with your patches on your giraffe!



<u>STEP 4</u>: Draw your template for you giraffe's ears and horns on a piece of card and cut them out (TOP TIP! Cut out one of each first and draw round them. This will make sure they both look the same.)



STEP 6: Draw around your ear templates on yellow felt and your horn templates on the brown felt you used for your patches.





<u>STEP 8</u>: Glue or tape your ears and horns to the top of you giraffe's head.



<u>STEP 5</u>: Position where you want them on the top of your giraffe's head.



<u>STEP 7</u>: Glue your felt ears and horns to your cardboard cut outs.





STEP 9: Cut out some eyes for your giraffe on white felt and glue them on.



<u>STEP 10</u>: Draw on your giraffe's features. Give your puppet some eyes, a snout and mouth, and draw on some extra patches if you choose. Your giraffe is now COMPLETE!
